How to Begin Bible Drill in September Efrain and Jennifer Gonzalez Youth Minister FBC Crosbyton

Bible Drill is an incredible program and tool that will allow students to study God's work and hide His Word in their hearts. But it can be very overwhelming! After over 15 years coaching children's, youth, and high school Bible Drill, here are some of our best tips!

- 1.) Have a schedule! We have shared ours with you for the Red Cycle. We do Bible Drill on Sundays but if you choose a different day of the week, simply change the dates. This allows everyone to have a plan. If students must miss, they do not get behind. Each week as we warm up, workers take students one at a time to work on these verses AND listen to any verses they have already learned from previous weeks. (and YES! I strategically placed some of the harder verses at the first while they are still motivated and fresh! They are not in order.)
- 2.) **Create a visual motivation board.** As students complete their verses, have a visual board to show their progress. This allows them to see the end goal and compete against those around them. This could be a racetrack, mountain to climb, or a simple star chart. Get creative. The kids love it. You can even have a prize for the first one to finish.
- 3.) **HAVE FUN and don't stress out.** Students will get behind. It's ok. With this schedule, all verses are learned before Christmas leaving us with lots of time to review and get faster. There will be plenty of time to catch up. This is just a guide.
- 4.) **Share this with parents.** Educate parents on the importance of working on verses at home. This allows you to practice verses at meetings and do lots of work on the line and with the Bible.

Bible Drill has proven to be such a powerful tool in the lives of my own personal children and so many that we have coached. I pray that this will be the same for your team. We can't wait to see you at State!
