

CHILDREN'S BIBLE DRILL – Grades 4, 5, 6 (CHURCH SAMPLE DRILL - GREEN CYCLE)

We have four different types of Drills:

**QUOTATION DRILL, COMPLETION DRILL
BOOK DRILL and KEY PASSAGE DRILL**

Our first drill is the **QUOTATION DRILL** and there will be six calls. I will give the reference. If the participant knows the verse, he steps forward on the command “START.” When called upon, the participant must quote the verse and give the reference.

If you can complete the verse, please step forward on the command start, prepared to quote the entire verse and give the reference. If I call on you during the drill for the correct response, you may ask me to repeat the verse again.
