

# Campamento 2026: Rules, Checklist & FAQ

---

## Before You Arrive

Make sure **ALL camp forms** are **printed, filled out, and signed!** This will make check-in **quick and easy.**

---

## What to Pack: Checklist

### Sleeping Items

- Sleeping bag OR twin-size bedding (fitted/flat sheet)
- Blanket & pillow
- Pajamas / sleepwear

### Toiletries

- 2 towels (one for shower, one for pool)
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Shampoo & conditioner
- Body wash or soap
- Deodorant
- Hair products
- Lotion

### Clothing

- Casual clothes for daily activities (5 days)
- Athletic wear for rec/sports
- Socks & undergarments for the week
- Modest sleepwear
- **Swimsuit:** One-piece only – wear a **dark-colored shirt** over it (no white shirts)
- Tennis shoes only (closed-toe required for rec & missions)

### Extras

- Printed & signed **Campamento forms**
- Bible
- Notebook or journal
- Pens, pencils, highlighters

- Backpack
  - Refillable water bottle
  - Sunscreen & bug spray
  - Snacks/water
  - Hat (optional)
  - Spending money (for stores, snacks, coffee shop)

## FAQ

### What's the Dress Code?

- No spaghetti straps or short shorts
- No vulgar/explicit graphic tees
- No white shirts in the pool
- Swimsuits must be one-piece with a **dark shirt** over it
- No two-piece swimsuits or shirtless swimming
- Tennis shoes required for rec and missions
- Leaders: Help students stay accountable by checking outfits before they leave dorms

### What Should Leaders Expect?

- Be prayerful and spiritually prepared – students will follow your lead!
  - Send legal first/last names + emails of ALL participants age 18+ to: **david.gonzalez@txb.org** (for MinistrySafe background checks)
  - Attend **Leader Workshops** on **Tuesday & Thursday**
  - Help enforce rules, schedules, and be Christ-like examples

## Camp Rules

### Behavior

- Treat everyone with respect (Golden Rule!)
- Follow the schedule – be on time and present
- Use the buddy system – no one should walk alone or be alone with someone of the opposite sex
- Boys stay out of girls' dorms and vice versa
- No PDA (Public Displays of Affection) – no hand-holding, kissing, hugging
- Keep hands to yourself – no play-fighting or touching others
- No bullying, harassment, or verbal/physical abuse
- No profanity or foul language

### Dress & Conduct

- Dress modestly and honor God with your choices
- No revealing or inappropriate clothing

- Leaders, please check campers' clothing before they leave the dorm

## Forbidden Items & Behavior

- No alcohol, tobacco, vape pens, drugs, or weapons
- No pranks, hazing, or bullying – zero tolerance
- No weapons / toy weapons
- No leaving dorms after curfew – students will be locked out
- No damaging or defacing DBU property
- No disrespect toward DBU staff, campus police, or Campamento staff

## Recreation Guidelines

- Show good sportsmanship
  - Respect referees and staff decisions
  - Keep a Christ-like attitude
- 

## Consequences

- Leaders will be asked to address issues within their group first
  - Serious issues may result in **immediate removal** from camp
  - If DBU campus security is involved, **their decisions are final** – we are guests on their campus
