Super Summer is a teaching ministry hidden in a camp. We support churches by teaching students to Know & Share The Gospel. Super Summer MVP is designed for college-age students who are who are passionate about equipping students with the gospel. MVPs will join with the Super Summer staff and other volunteers from across Texas to prepare for and serve at the sessions of Super Summer. Preparations for Super Summer include inventory and packaging of supplies and administrative assignments. Service at Super Summer includes service as a Team Leader or various roles of Support Staff (Office, Team Building, Merchandise, Program, Safety Patrol) and Executive Staff (Assistant Dean, Team Leader Coordinator, School Worship Leader).

HOUSING, MEALS, & TRANSPORTATION

Housing: Super Summer does not provide housing during the volunteer assignments in Dallas. Super Summer does provide housing during the Super Summer sessions.

Meals: Super Summer does not provide meals during the volunteer assignments in Dallas. Super Summer does provide meals during the Super Summer sessions.

Transportation: Super Summer does not provide transportation during the volunteer assignments in Dallas. There are occasions in which MVPs are asked to drive their own vehicles to and from the Super Summer sessions (mileage reimbursements are given), but usually only one extra car is needed.

PER DIEM (WHAT DOES THAT EVEN MEAN?!)

Great question! A weekly per diem will be given to help cover personal expenses that may be incurred during the term of the volunteer assignment as a Super Summer MVP.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applicants must complete the [Missionary Volunteer Application](#).
- Applicants must also submit one recommendation from each of the following:
 - *Personal reference*
 - *Professional reference*
 - *Ministerial reference*
 - *Family member reference*
- Please provide references from both male(s) and female(s).
- All references must have known the applicant for 6+ months.
- One of the above references should know the applicant in relation to serving children and/or students.
- Reference forms are automatically emailed to the references listed on the application at the time that the application is submitted. Notify all references to expect a reference form via email and encourage them to complete the form upon receipt.
- Applicants must consent to a background check ([link to follow application](#)).
- Applicants must complete Sexual Abuse Awareness Training through MinistrySafe ([link to follow application](#)).

Applicants are requested to introduce themselves and get to know the Super Summer team through a meet and greet via Zoom, preferably in December.
