Call to Order:

Dustin Slaton, member of the Institutional Relations Committee, called the meeting to order. Slaton chaired the meeting in place of Bobby Contreras who could not attend.

Devotional and Prayer:

Afterward, he presented a Recommendation for Re-endorsement of Dallas Baptist University's (DBU) graduate ministry degrees for Ministerial Financial Assistance (MFA). IRC voted affirmatively; the motion passed.

Slaton adjourned the meeting thanking everyone and dismissed the guests. IRC stayed for an executive session that followed.
