How do I apply?

1. Complete the online application at gonowmissions.com
2. Submit 3 online references and an unofficial transcript.
3. Be interviewed by your local BSM or Baptist church.
4. Attend Discovery Day, October 7, 2023 in one of four locations.



Qualifications

- Committed and maturing Christian.
- Active in BSM and a Baptist church, active in BSM and an Evangelical church, or active in a Baptist church in Texas.
- Participating in ministry and/or leadership in BSM or local church.
- Willing to participate in personal evangelism.
- Be in at least your first semester of college after high school. Go Now Missions is for college students only.
- Attending/enrolled in university or seminary in Texas or graduated in the last 6 months, or student attending school out of state whose home church is a Baptist church in Texas.
- Minimum grade point average of 2.25.
- Must be between 18 and 27 years old on Dec. 1, 2023 for Christmas and Spring missions.
- Meet special requirements for specific projects. (These are included in the listed descriptions).
- Committed to raising the amount of money for the position to which you are appointed.
- If apply for international trip, must either have passport or have applied for one and expedited the processing by October 6, 2023.

What is Discovery Day?

Discovery Day is a time set aside for you to “discover” how God wants to use you in His global purpose. It involves small groups, fundraising training, and individual interview, and much more. Following Discovery Day, students are notified about where they are invited to serve.

Discovery Day will be held at the UTA BSM, South Texas, West Texas, and East Texas Retreat on Saturday, October 7, 2023. You will receive more information about Discovery Day after you have applied. Appointments are made from Discovery Day interviews.

Frequently Asked Questions

How many college credit hours do I need to apply?

You must be in at least your first semester of college after high school graduation. Some positions require completion of additional semesters.

What does “total cost of project” mean?

This is what it costs to send a student missionary on this project. It includes transportation (to, from, and on the field), housing, meals, insurance, shots, personal incidentals, visa, training materials, orientation, and debriefing (does not cover cost of passport).

What does “amount you raise” mean?

This is the portion of the cost that you will raise if appointed to the project. The balance between this and the total cost of the project is raised by BSM (Baptist Student Ministry) groups across Texas. You will receive fundraising training when appointed.

What if I cannot attend the Discovery Day?

Call the Go Now office now. We will work with you to set up an additional interview. 817-277-4077.

Can former Go Now Missionaries apply?

Yes! If you served before, you will need to complete a new application. If you would like a copy of your old application emailed to you, contact Go Now.

Can graduating seniors and graduate students apply?

Yes! Students are eligible to apply for up to 6 months following graduation. Seminary and graduate students are welcome to apply.

What if I have questions?

What if my parents are concerned about me serving?

A Taste of South Asia

MISSION FOCUS: Evangelism, Discipleship, Prayer Walking

DATE: Dec. 27, 2023 - Jan. 8, 2024

This winter come get a taste of South Asia! Home to the greatest concentration of lostness on the planet, South Asia is full of beautiful people, diverse geography, and many different religions. You will explore this exciting place through our cultural exchange program. On this trip, we will learn together about culture, as well as receive practical missions training and coaching. You will be involved in daily trainings and teachings in the mornings and in the afternoon and evenings will be engaging the city in prayer walking, evangelism, follow-ups, and discipleship. Your time will be full of opportunities to engage the lost and disciple local believers. Come see how God is at work and how you can join Him in what He is doing in South Asia!

LOCATION: South Asia

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must have a passport or have applied and paid to expedite passport process by Oct. 6, 2023. Looking for students that are flexible, have positive attitudes, listen and obey instructions, and are mature. Open to a variety of skills, majors, and gifts. Not required, but an excellent trip for those who have a desire to see what this work is like and have an interest in serving for a summer, semester, or longer. After appointment, you will be required to be vaccinated for: Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, & Typhoid by Dec 1, 2023. (Will be reimbursed for required shots.)

TEAM: 12 Students (4 from any school in Texas, 4 from TX State, 4 from UH), 1 Adult Coordinator (Already Filled)

AMOUNT YOU RAISE: \$2980 (\$4260 Total cost of project)

TOTAL COST OF PROJECT AND THE AMOUNT YOU RAISE

The “amount you raise” is the minimum portion of the amount you will raise if appointed to the project. It includes transportation, housing, meals, insurance, shots, personal incidentals, visa, training materials, interviews, and orientation. The balance between the two is raised by BSM groups all across Texas. In effect, all students serving through Go Now receive a scholarship. Any funds you raise above the minimum amount will be applied to the total cost of the project.

Christmas Missions

Camels and Candy Canes

MISSION FOCUS: College, Evangelism, Urban Outreach

DATE: Dec. 27, 2023 - Jan. 6, 2024

Come spend your Christmas break sharing truth with the Muslim university students through our cultural exchange program. You'll build relationships with English-speaking students and share your hope with them while you immerse yourself in the culture of one of the busiest cities on earth. You'll see the sites, encourage long-term workers, assist with outreach events, and engage deeply with new local friends. Your week with us will include days of orientation and training, visits to world-famous tourist sites, worship and prayer with our team, and lots of hours out with your new local friends. You'll be a learner, a partner, a sower, and a friend. The harvest is plentiful – come and work the field!

LOCATION: North Africa

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must have a passport or have applied and paid to expedite passport process by Oct. 6, 2023. Flexibility, humility, and a learner's attitude are key qualities needed. Must be comfortable conversing with lots of people with varying degrees of English proficiency and have a genuine interest in their culture and lives. After appointment, you will be required to be vaccinated for: Hepatitis A & Hepatitis B by Dec 1, 2023. (Will be reimbursed for required shots.)

TEAM: 6 Students (At Least 2 Males)

AMOUNT YOU RAISE: \$2599 (\$3710 Total cost of project)



Christmas in the Valley

MISSION FOCUS: Community Outreach, Construction, Children

DATE: Dec. 15, 2023 - Dec. 21, 2023

Join us as we serve families along the Rio Grande Valley and border with Mexico. Many families live in extreme poverty and face harsh winter conditions with little to no resources. Our hope is to share the love of Christ by constructing beds for families who currently live without, and by distributing basic hygiene items and blankets to help families stay warm and healthy during the winter season. We will also spend a few days sorting, packing, and distributing gifts for children in hopes of making their Christmas a little brighter. We hope you will join us as we celebrate and share the story of Jesus' birth with everyone we encounter.

LOCATION: McAllen, TX

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: No special skills required; you just need a willing heart to serve and learn. Bilingual-English/Spanish is helpful.

TEAM: 8 Students

AMOUNT YOU RAISE: \$565 Plus cost of flights if needed. Flight costs added to amount to raise. Does not include cost of travel if you choose to drive. (\$750 Total cost of project)

Christmas of Compassion

MISSION FOCUS: Community Outreach, Children, Youth, Homeless

DATE: Dec. 10, 2023 - Dec. 16, 2023

Serving at Mission Centers of Houston during the Christmas season is very focused and intentional! You will be preparing and assisting in Christmas ministries as we share the Good News of the birth of Jesus in all our age-grade ministries. This includes Christmas luncheon for the homeless; parties for children, youth, and senior adults; and a Christmas Store as we continue to serve in our ongoing ministries. You will also have a chance to serve with our new Compassion Center ministry, organizing donated items to assist 25 of our Compassion Network partners in their gospel ministries. As you immerse yourself in our surrounding under-resourced Hispanic neighborhoods, you will see your vision, heart, and skills for missions grow exponentially!

LOCATION: Houston, TX

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Individuals who are kingdom-minded, focused, self-starters, and hard working will excel at this ministry. Spanish is helpful but not required. Must have completed finals before arrival in Houston.

Holiday Helpers

MISSION FOCUS: Social Work, Meeting Physical Needs, Case Management

DATE: Jan 2, 2024 - Jan. 9, 2024

Samaritan House Family Ministries provides emergency shelter to women and children who are experiencing a housing crisis. We seek to create a home environment for residents as they work toward self-sufficiency. As shelter helpers/assistants you will have the opportunity to work directly with residents, spending quality time with adults and children. Sometimes special activities are planned and implemented by the staff. It is important to be flexible and to be able to handle any situation that may arise. Samaritan House is a safe and secure environment where families can build a sense of family with everyone. Children are a main focus for us, so we pay extra attention to opportunities to mentor our youngest residents. Whether it is helping with homework or just listening, we desire to make every child feel welcome, safe, and special while they are here. The house has rules of conduct for all residents. As a volunteer staff, you will be responsible to set a good example and monitor rules of the shelter.

Intentional Internship

MISSION FOCUS: Youth, Discipleship

DATE: Dec. 17, 2023 - Dec. 23, 2023 OR Dec. 27 - Jan. 02, 2024

Come help meet a tangible need that directly impacts the lives of students ages 12 to 18 who are not able to live with their parents but live at the Texas Baptists Children's Home. You will help provide activities during their Christmas break. As a youth ministry intern you will be responsible for helping the youth develop a closer, deeper relationship with Christ as Savior and Lord of their lives. You will assist in planning youth events and leading discussions, games, and activities. You will help with behavior management at the programs and maintain a positive relationship with the youth. You will also help administrate the programs (attendance, advertising, setup, and tear down). The youth are in attendance from 8 a.m. - 6 p.m. daily, with occasional evening activities.

LOCATION: Round Rock, TX

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must be intentional, relational, active, and willing to be engaged with youth. Youth ministry experience is helpful but not required.

If a project lists Sophomore or above, you must be in your 2nd year of college after high school at the time of application. Junior or above, in 3rd year, etc.

Sharing Christ with the Nations

MISSION FOCUS: Evangelism, Internationals, Meeting Physical Needs

DATE: Dec. 15, 2023 - Dec. 22, 2023 OR Dec. 28 - Jan. 04, 2024

We desire to be a blessing to the men and women who work on the cruise and cargo ships that come to Port Canaveral by meeting their physical, emotional, and spiritual needs so they may know God's love. Depending on skill sets, your team will handle different tasks at the Seafarer Center, which may include direct ministry to crew such as leading worship music, leading Bible studies, sharing one-on-one, discipleship, receive and distribute packages, greet/sign in, or helping prepare lunch. Indirect ministry may include developing social media, maintaining building and grounds, and cleaning vehicles. You will also have opportunities to visit on cargo ships and provide ministry there. Ship visits involve spending time conversing with crew members and sharing the gospel with them. We take materials in their language and make them available for free. The world is at our doorstep! Come join us in reaching it.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Be a Jesus follower with a servant heart.

Spirit of Giving

MISSION FOCUS: Meeting Physical Needs, Community Outreach, Evangelism

DATE: Dec. 15, 2023 - Dec. 22, 2023

The Christmas Season is a time for celebrating our Lord, Jesus Christ; showing love to those around us; and embracing a spirit of giving. We host a Christmas Store where parents receive toys for their children and every adult who comes through hears the story of Christ's birth, shared from the Scriptures, and narrated by creative and faithful storytellers. You will assist in the Christmas Store, stocking shelves, assisting shoppers, and providing childcare. You will join the Mission Arlington family by helping stock the food pantry, manage the clothing room, organize donations, office work, and other day to day activities. You will also assist a Mission Arlington apartment church. Mission Arlington is not an organization but a way of life. We simply get to spend all our days serving and teaching others about Jesus. Days begin with a morning devotional and we work until 7 p.m. Come be the hands and feet of Jesus in Arlington.

Christmas Missions

Won by One

MISSION FOCUS: Construction, Meeting Physical Needs

DATE: Dec. 17, 2023 - Dec. 23, 2023

Harmons is an under-resourced community with nearly 2 of every 3 people under-employed. Because of expense and its remote location, consistent education past the 6th grade is often difficult. Money for basic needs (food, clothes, toiletries, medical treatment, and home improvements) is limited. The mission of Won by One is to show the love of Jesus Christ by providing opportunities through education, empowerment, discipleship, and economic development. Each day your team will split into groups to work alongside the local people constructing houses, repairing homes, assisting



in schools, being a Reading Pal, or taking Faith Walks to engage and share with the people. Evangelism is done through discussions on work sites and time in the courtyard. We spend time getting to know Jamaicans and then use those relationships to share the free gift of Christ's salvation with them. Won by One exists to glorify God and make disciples by empowering lives.

LOCATION: Harmons, Jamaica

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must have a passport or have applied and paid to expedite passport process by Oct. 6, 2023. Must be servant hearted and willing to work hard. No construction experience needed but must be physically able to do the work. After appointment, you will be required to be vaccinated for: Hepatitis A & Hepatitis B by Dec 1, 2023. (Will be reimbursed for required shots.)

TEAM: 20 Students (10 from any school in Texas, 10 Students from Waco BSM), 1 Adult Coordinator (Already Filled)

AMOUNT YOU RAISE: \$1690 (\$2400 Total cost of project)

PASSPORTS

If you are considering a international project and do not already have a passport you need to apply for an expedited passport immediately. Passports are taking longer to process so people who have not applied and expedited their passport by October, 8, will not be appointed internationally.



Aloha International Ministries

MISSION FOCUS: College, Internationals, Unreached Peoples

DATE: Jan. 8, 2024 - May 14, 2024

Over 70% of international students coming to the U.S. never set foot inside an American's home. Several thousand students come to Oahu from all over the world to attend one of our universities, many from countries with the least access to the gospel. International ministries exist to joyfully lead and equip churches in welcoming, reaching, discipling, and sending international students and residents to reach the nations. Come serve for a semester, meeting international students, forming friendships, sharing the gospel, and discipling students. Activities include teaching English classes, leading Global Cafe, International Luncheon, meeting with students one-on-one, and leading fun activities around the island. The ministry is very relationally focused, and we are seeking to build relationships that can carry the weight of the gospel. We are also looking for boldness in sharing the gospel as well as sharing personal testimonies of God's ongoing and recent work in your life. You may choose to stay longer to help lead or participate in an international mission trip in the summer following your service. (There will be an additional cost for this trip.)

LOCATION: Honolulu, HI

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must be a Junior or above (in third year of college after high school graduation). Cross-cultural ministry experience is essential for this position. This means either serving internationally in the past or experience working with international students on your campus. Hawaii is a very different cultural setting than the U.S. Mainland, and you will be working with international students from around the world, predominantly from Asia. Experience sharing the gospel and leading a Bible study is essential. You need to be flexible, teachable, and must be able to take initiative. Experience with teaching English as a Second Language is helpful but not required. Second language experience is helpful but not required.

Spring Semester Missions

Collegian to Collegian - Hands On (RCRW)

MISSION FOCUS: College, Evangelism, Discipleship

DATE: Jan. 22, 2024 - July 15, 2024



The urban centers of South Asia are filled with millions of college students who dream of making an impact on the world. Less tied to South Asian culture and religion than their parents, these students are becoming increasingly open to new ideas and are generally open to spiritual conversations. Your job will be focused on building relationships with students and sharing the hope we have in Jesus with them. As students show interest, you will have the opportunity to follow up with them and begin discipling new believers.

You will also be involved in equipping local believers to share their faith and make disciples on their campuses by training alongside local churches in the city. This is an opportunity to serve on mission while being mentored by a field missionary. You will also participate in the Hands On orientation and debriefing.

LOCATION: South Asia

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must have a passport or have applied and paid to expedite passport process by Oct. 6, 2023. Must be a Sophomore or above (in second year of college after high school graduation). Must be a member of a Baptist Church. Need to be relational and willing to meet new people. Experience with International ministry is helpful but not required. Be prepared to encounter lots of people, smells, sights, colors, and sounds. Must be in good health, able to endure extensive walking/standing, extreme hot and cold, poor air quality, and large crowds. Those with severe asthma, adverse reaction to crowds and activities requiring physical exertion should not apply. After appointment, you will be required to be vaccinated or get meds for Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Typhoid, Malaria, & Japanese Encephalitis by Dec 1, 2023. (Will be reimbursed for required shots.)

TEAM: 2 Students, Same Gender

AMOUNT YOU RAISE: \$4950 (\$8900 Total cost of project)

TOTAL COST OF PROJECT AND THE AMOUNT YOU RAISE

The "amount you raise" is the minimum portion of the amount you will raise if appointed to the project. It includes transportation, housing, meals, insurance, shots, personal incidentals, visa, training materials, interviews, and orientation. The balance between the two is raised by BSM groups all across Texas. In effect, all students serving through Go Now receive a scholarship. Any funds you raise above the minimum amount will be applied to the total cost of the project.

MISSION FOCUS: Children, Community Outreach, Evangelism

DATE: Jan. 8, 2024 - May 18, 2024

Mission Arlington is more a movement than a strategy, more a spirit than a structure, more like a family than an organization. It's not about religion, and it is as much about God as it is about people. When you join us, you will get to help with a variety of projects at Mission Arlington and in the apartment complexes as we seek to be the hands and feet of Jesus. You will join the Mission Arlington family and help with the day-to-day activities. You will help stock the food pantry, manage the clothing room, organize donations, work around the office, and other day-to-day activities. You will also be assigned a Mission Arlington apartment church to join and help assist with. This will include Bible study, afterschool programs, youth activities and other events that the apartment church is part of. Be ready to serve 7 days a week, beginning with a morning devotional with the Mission Arlington team, and working until 7 p.m. You will serve around the mission and head out to the apartments in the afternoon time. Recovery and Redemption

MISSION FOCUS: Social Work/Justice, Discipleship, Internationals,

DATE: Jan. 8, 2024 - June 12, 2024

Dton Naam is a non-profit that entails three programs to help male and trans sex workers get out of prostitution and exploitative experiences. We walk alongside them through recovery and job training, and even help them finish any education they are interested in finishing. Our programs include: Outreach weekly in 3 main Bangkok red light districts; Recovery - operating a full-time recovery program with social work, support groups and relevant classes needed; and Job Training - operating a small job training program inside a cafe/bakery. Depending on your skills and capacities, we will ask you to focus in either our recovery program or helping in our job training program. Most students that intern with Dton Naam will be able to help with outreach weekly, being paired with an experienced staff and helping build trust and relationships with the trans and male sex workers within Bangkok. We are seeking students that have a heart for helping sexworkers find healing and healthier options, but also students studying relevant majors, such as social work, counseling, teaching, business, pastry chefs, and/or other related fields.

LOCATION: Bangkok, Thailand

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must have a passport or have applied and paid to expedite passport process by Oct. 6, 2023. Must be a Junior or above (in third year of college after high school graduation). Must be eager, teachable, and have a positive attitude. We are looking for creative, optimistic, and compassionate individuals with experiences or majors related to social work, counseling, teaching, business, art therapy, marketing, baristaing, or baking. If you can get school credit, please let us know what that entails. Our team would mentor you. After appointment, you will be required to be vaccinated for: Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, & Typhoid by Dec 1, 2023. (Will be reimbursed for required shots.)

PASSPORTS

Refuge Ministry Internship

MISSION FOCUS: Refugees, Unreached Peoples, Teaching English

DATE: Jan. 8, 2024 - March 1, 2024 **OR** March 18, 2024 - May 10, 2024

Come make Disciples Among Refugees! Refugee Ministry Interns will minister to Syrian, Afghan, Somali, Iraqi, Rohingya, and many other displaced peoples living in Phoenix, AZ. The team which you will work alongside has hundreds of connections and can quickly help you meet the people you will serve. As you live in community with refugees, you will be their neighbor and provide personalized ministry as you discover specific needs such as transportation, job acquisition, and homework help for kids. You will share Jesus stories with refugee friends, live among them in apartment communities, and facilitate disciple-making relationships among unreached peoples that are represented here in the U.S. GoTEN also offers services to refugees such as English classes, sewing classes, and other services as needed that help establish new connections. You will also have the option of volunteering at the GoTEN Training Center. Training will take place throughout the internship to equip you for this ministry role, and possibly even a longer career in diaspora mission work.

LOCATION: Phoenix, AZ

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must be a Sophomore or above (in second year of college after high school graduation).
