With over 1200 contacts being made by each of our four MAP Mobilizer, communicating the vision of MAP (promotion), and the enlistment of sponsor churches, we believe that if 5% of contacts respond favorably and become sponsor churches that would give us the capacity of sponsoring 240 more missionaries.

With the increase visibility and impact of MAP among our Texas Baptists churches we hope to have sufficient support for this project to be self-supporting in the future.
