MENTORING AND COACHING OF PASTORS THAT COMPLETE THE 12 TRAINING SESSIONS.

- •Participating pastors will be assigned another Hispanic pastor to serve as mentor and coach.
- Participating pastors will have a weekly conference call with their mentor/coach.
- Participating pastors will have a monthly face-to-face meeting with their mentor/coach.

THE PURPOSE OF THE CONFERENCE CALLS AND THE FACE-TO-FACE MEETINGS IS

To pray together, provide a support system for participating pastors and follow-up on the implementation of what they learned during the 12 teaching sessions.


