### PARTICIPANT GUIDELINES

In an effort to make BOUNCE a positive experience for all involved we ask that all participants agree to certain guidelines. The BOUNCE Participant Guidelines will be listed on the PARTICIPANT FORM that all participants must sign along with their parent/guardian. The BOUNCE Participant Guidelines are listed below.

#### As a BOUNCE Mission Participant:

- I will seek to reflect Christ as I serve by participating in all aspects of the BOUNCE experience (worksite, ministry, worship, youth group reflections, etc.) and will observe the BOUNCE schedule.
- I will abide by guidelines established by the BOUNCE leadership team while at BOUNCE (dress code, accessible areas of lodging facility, lights out, etc.).
- For my safety and health, I understand no alcohol, tobacco, nonprescription drugs, fireworks, firearms, knives, or weapons of any kind are allowed at BOUNCE.
- Due to the serious nature of BOUNCE Mission work, I understand pranks and prank paraphernalia are not allowed.
- I agree to observe all safe worksite practices established by the BOUNCE leadership team.
- I realize that BOUNCE is a Kingdom approach to mission service.
   That being the case, participants from other churches will be partnering with me and my church for service. I will respect them, their privacy, and their possessions as we partner together for Kingdom service.
- I understand I cannot leave the worksite or lodging facility without the permission of the mission coordinator and my group leader.
- I understand girls should not be in boys' rooms, and boys should not be in girls' rooms. I further understand that public displays of affection (PDA) are not allowed between girlfriends and boyfriends while at BOUNCE.

## PARTICIPANT GUIDELINES

- I am grateful our lodging facility has agreed to host us for the week
  of BOUNCE. I will make every effort to take care of the facility, keep
  it clean, and respect the facility and grounds during the week. I also
  understand any damages to property are my personal responsibility.
- I will seek to glorify God through my hard work, my positive attitude, and my healthy relationships during the entire BOUNCE experience.
- I understand my persistent failure to abide by the BOUNCE Participant Guidelines could result in an early trip home at my parent's/guardian's expense.

## TIME ALONE WITH GOD —— Introduction ——

Spending time with God is the most vital part of our walk with God. It is how we know God, how we connect with God, and how we get the strength to live the Christian life each day. Without time with the Lord, we will wander through life without purpose, wondering what God truly has for us and not experiencing the abundant life Jesus told us about in John 10:10.

For your week at BOUNCE, we have prepared a guide that will help you spend time with God. For some of you, this will be your first time, and we hope that this will continue when you head back home. For others of you, this is a part of your daily walk. We want to encourage you to dive deeper into your relationship with God.

Each day our quiet time will have three parts:

- A brief introduction
- A passage to read in God's Word and some questions for you to reflect upon
- · A time of focused prayer

We want to challenge you to make time with God a priority this week and when you go back home. If you have any questions about quiet time material when you get home, check with your group leader.



# TIME ALONE WITH GOD Ministry Day 1 ——

#### Promises from the Psalms

As we spend this week learning about some of the promises of God, our quiet times are going to be spent reading in the Psalms. The promises of God are evident all throughout the book of Psalms. I hope you will take this time each day to draw closer to God and experience His presence through His Word.

#### READ Psalm 1

<sup>1</sup> How happy is the man who does not follow the advice of the wicked or take the path of sinners or join a group of mockers! <sup>2</sup>Instead, his delight is in the Lord's instruction, and he meditates on it day and night. <sup>3</sup>He is like a tree planted beside streams of water that bears its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers. <sup>4</sup>The wicked are not like this; instead, they are like chaff that the wind blows away. <sup>5</sup>Therefore the wicked will not survive the judgment, and sinners will not be in the community of the righteous. <sup>6</sup>For the Lord watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked leads to ruin.

#### RESPOND

What do we learn about following God in this passage?

What promises of God do you see in this Psalm?

What will we experience if we live in obedience to the Word of God?

#### **PRAY**

Praise the Lord for who He is based on what you have read today.

Confess any sin in your life and any area where Jesus is not #1.

Ask for wisdom and physical strength as you serve today.

# TIME ALONE WITH GOD Ministry Day 2 ——

#### Read Psalm 23

<sup>1</sup>The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I lack. <sup>2</sup>He lets me lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside quiet waters. <sup>3</sup>He renews my life; He leads me along the right paths for His name's sake. <sup>4</sup>Even when I go through the darkest valley, I fear no danger, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff—they comfort me. <sup>5</sup>You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. <sup>6</sup>Only goodness and faithful love will pursue me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord as long as I live.

#### **RESPOND:**

There are many promises of God that we see in this Psalm. Write down what promises of God you see as you read this famous Psalm.

How should you live today knowing the promises of God that you listed?

#### **PRAY**

Take time to sit quietly thinking about God and what you have learned this morning. After some time of silence, talk to God about whatever is on your heart.





# TIME ALONE WITH GOD Ministry Day 3 ——

#### Read Psalm 46

<sup>1</sup>God is our refuge and strength, a helper who is always found in times of trouble. <sup>2</sup>Therefore we will not be afraid, though the earth trembles and the mountains topple into the depths of the seas, <sup>3</sup>though its waters roar and foam and the mountains quake with its turmoil. Selah <sup>4</sup>There is a river— its streams delight the city of God, the holy dwelling place of the Most High. <sup>5</sup>God is within her; she will not be toppled. God will help her when the morning dawns. <sup>6</sup>Nations rage, kingdoms topple; the earth melts when He lifts His voice. <sup>7</sup>The Lord of Hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our stronghold. Selah <sup>8</sup>Come, see the works of the Lord, who brings devastation on the earth. <sup>9</sup>He makes wars cease throughout the earth. He shatters bows and cuts spears to pieces; He burns up the chariots. <sup>10</sup>"Stop your fighting— and know that I am God, exalted among the nations, exalted on the earth." <sup>12</sup>Yahweh of Hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our stronghold. Selah

#### **RESPOND**

What are some of the major promises of God in this passage?

This Psalm tells us that God is a stronghold. What does it mean that God is a stronghold in your life?

Verse 10 is a verse many people know. In many translations of the Bible it says, "Be still and know that I am God." What is God telling us in this verse? What does it mean to be still?

The overwhelming theme of this Psalm is that God is with us! Take a moment and write down a prayer of thanksgiving to God for His presence in your life.

## TIME ALONE WITH GOD Ministry Day 4

#### INFLUENCERS Know How To Live.

This is it! Your last day on your BOUNCE ministry site. Hopefully it has been a great experience for you as you have served the Lord and served others. You have been showing others the presence, peace and power of God as you have served. You have also shown so many of God's promises of hope! Today will be a challenge to power through as you are physically exhausted but remember you have the presence of God and His strength to bring you through!

#### **READ Psalm 100**

<sup>1</sup>Shout triumphantly to the Lord, all the earth. <sup>2</sup>Serve the Lord with gladness; come before Him with joyful songs. <sup>3</sup>Acknowledge that Yahweh is God. He made us, and we are His — His people, the sheep of His pasture. <sup>4</sup>Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise. Give thanks to Him and praise His name. <sup>5</sup>For Yahweh is good, and His love is eternal; His faithfulness endures through all generations.

#### **RESPOND**

What does this Psalm teach us about how we are to respond to the Lord?


What does it tell us about who we are?
