- Committed and maturing Christian.
- Active in a BSM and a Baptist church, active in a BSM and an Evangelical church, or active in a Baptist church in Texas.
- Participating in ministry and/or leadership in a BSM or a local church.
- Willing to participate in personal evangelism.
- At least in your first semester of college after high school. Go Now Missions is for college students only.
- Attending/enrolled in university or seminary in Texas or graduated in the last 6 months, or student attending school out of state whose home church is a Baptist church in Texas.
- Minimum grade point average of 2.25.
- Must be between 18 and 27 years old on May 1, 2022 for Summer, Impact, and Fall Semester missions.
- Meet special requirements for specific projects. (These are included in the listed descriptions of each project).
- Committed to raising the amount of money for the position to which you are appointed.



Discovery Weekend is a time set aside for you to "discover" how God wants to use you in His global purpose. <u>The weekend involves worship, small groups, a mission fair, fundraising training, an individual interview, and much more.</u> Following Discovery Weekend, <u>you will be notified where you have been invited to serve.</u>

Discovery Weekend will be February 11-13, 2022 in the Dallas area. You will receive more information about Discovery Weekend after you have applied. Appointments are made from Discovery Weekend interviews.



How many college credit hours do I need to apply?

You must be in at least your first semester of college after high school graduation when you apply. Some positions require completion of additional semesters.

What does "total cost of project" mean?

This is what it costs to send a student missionary on this project. It includes transportation (to, from, and on the field), housing, meals, insurance, shots, personal incidentals, visa, training materials, orientation, and debriefing (does not cover cost of passport).

What does "amount you raise" mean?

This is the portion of the cost that you will raise if appointed to the project. The balance between this and the total cost of the project is raised by BSM (Baptist Student Ministry) groups across Texas. You will receive fundraising training when appointed.

What if I cannot attend Discovery Weekend?

Call the Go Now office now. We will work with you to set up an additional interview. 817-277-4077.

Can former Go Now Missionaries apply?

Yes! If you served before, you will need to complete a new application. If you would like a copy of your old application emailed to you, contact Go Now.

Can graduating seniors and graduate students apply?

Yes! Students are eligible to apply for up to 6 months following graduation. Seminary and graduate students are welcome to apply.

What if I have questions?

Respect them. Share the Go Now website with them and let them know there is a Parent FAQ section. Involve them in your decision making and inform them about events and deadlines.




Activities Intern

MISSION FOCUS: Children's Ministry, Lifeguarding

DATE: May 23 - Aug. 5, 2022, Orientation May 20 - 22, 2022

You will serve at a children's home and be tasked to love, serve, and do activities with kids ranging from newborns to Senior in high school. You will have opportunities to babysit and possibly lifeguard. There will be numerous opportunities to play and provide games with

our kids like dodgeball, tag, volleyball, basketball, kickball, red-light green-light and many others. You will get to supervise kids as they go on outings to the zoo, paintball, movies, and baseball games. Your most important responsibility is building relationships that are encouraging and glorifying to God with these kids and their house parents. You will have the opportunity to live out your faith and do life with kids, showing the love and truth of Jesus Christ every day. We need students that are dedicated to their faith and are willing to serve with a servant's heart this upcoming summer.

You must be willing to respect and relate to this culture or you will be offensive and give Jesus and our church a bad name. You will help us reach our community through block parties, Acts of Kindness events, Vacation Bible School, Kid's Clubs, Youth & Children's Church, and going door to door to see how we can meet the needs of our neighbors. MISSION FOCUS: Collegiate Ministry, Community Outreach DATE: June 15 - Aug. 1, 2022, Orientation May 20 - 22, 2022

Our church is near several college campuses and our desire is to begin prayer walking, having conversations with students, and creating some casual summer environments to establish relationships and encourage spiritual conversations around life and the Gospel of Jesus. MISSION FOCUS: Teach English, Youth Ministry

DATE: May 23 - July 31, 2022, Orientation May 20 - 22, 2022

If you are wanting to learn and serve, seeking a growing relationship with the Lord, responding to God's leading to share the Gospel in word and deed, and ready for hard work outside of your comfort zones, then we need you here! MISSION FOCUS: Bike Ministry, Children's Ministry

DATE: May 23 - Aug. 1, 2022, Orientation May 20 - 22, 2022

Do you have a heart for ministering practically to kids during their summer break? What about helping to implement a new summer bicycle club? You will provide weekly training for school children on bicycle safety and skills. For the kids who complete their "basics" classes, you will provide opportunities to explore different types of bicycles and formats, including mountain biking, racing, gravel, cross country, etc. You will work with your supervisor to hone your personal evangelism skills, have daily spiritual application drills, have physical health awareness, and take advantage of church relations opportunities. We love our neighbors as ourselves. You will be ministering to all ages and all ethnicities. We will be in mostly lower-income areas but not all of our apartment communities are in low-income areas. The Northwest is a beautiful place so enjoy it while you are here ministering among the people in apartment communities who need Jesus.

MISSION FOCUS: Deaf Ministry, Children's & Youth Ministry

Are you fluent in ASL, looking to improve your ASL skills, or love working with the Deaf community and kids? The Deaf Camp is an 8-week day camp provided for Deaf and hard of hearing children, their hearing siblings, and hearing children of Deaf parents. You will have the opportunity to work with young children, teenagers, Deaf and hearing staff, Deaf and hard of hearing campers, and their families. These 2 months of Deaf Camp will provide you experience with the Deaf community and children, ASL receptive and expressive skills, and leadership skills.

MISSION FOCUS: Youth Ministry,

Disciple-Making

DATE: June 2 - Aug. 1, 2022, Orientation

May 20 - 22, 2022

Engage and equip youth with evangelism and discipleship! You will partner with Baptist youth and use your interests to share the gospel and gather youth groups for discipleship. More than 60% of Zambia is under the age of 30. It is a vast harvest opportunity and a

great mission force to be equipped. By the time you finish your summer, we pray there is a team of disciples in Solwezi continuing to make more disciples as you leave. Your first stop after you leave home will be a joint orientation with other Nehemiah Teams (NT). You will return to the U.S. for a joint debrief with other Nehemiah Teams. Participants must attend the entire program from NT Orientation through the end of debriefing.

LOCATION: Zambia

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must have a passport or have applied for one by Feb. 4, 2022. Must be willing and able to walk or ride a bicycle to and from ministry sites. There will be extensive walking, extreme heat, and humidity.

AMOUNT YOU RAISE: \$3,350 (\$5,150 total cost of project)

East African Refugees

MISSION FOCUS: Refugee Ministry, Children's Ministry

DATE: June 2 - Aug. 1, 2022, Orientation May 20 - 22, 2022

His light, His love, and His joy are breaking into the darkness through friendships. Your task is to develop community with the refugee families who have lived in the Midwest for up to twenty years while maintaining traditional dress, cooking, and folk Islam practices. The children in this neighborhood are the second generation to live in the USA. Few have ever visited Africa. Their English skills are significantly higher quality than their parents. They are obedient to traditions out of respect, but their hearts and minds are becoming western. Their souls are confused, conflicted, and could be ripe for harvest. Part of your training will be to learn and understand honor-shame based cultures and to use biblical stories in the context of an honor-shame mentality. Parents tenaciously hold to tradition, many fathers still follow Sharia, Islam law, and many mothers have horror stories of fleeing Eastern African countries. They also have heart-breaking stories of shame assimilating into Western culture and American school systems, while trying to learn English to survive. Be HIS light, love and joy this summer! Your first stop after you leave home will be a joint orientation with other Nehemiah Teams (NT). You will return to the U.S. for a joint debrief with other Nehemiah Teams. Participants must attend the entire program from NT Orientation through the end of debriefing.

LOCATION: Columbus, OH

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Able to build relationships and invest in people. Helpful but not required is previous experience with refugees, immigrants, or International students.

AMOUNT YOU RAISE: \$1,850 (\$2,285 total cost of project)

Eco Adventure

MISSION FOCUS: Outdoor Ministry, Unreached Peoples

DATE: June 2 - Aug. 1, 2022, Orientation May 20 - 22, 2022

One million people. No believers. No churches. IT IS hard to do ministry, but it's a beautiful, tropical place to live. You will be using your interests, hobbies, and eco/outdoor tourism to develop relationships and build bridges to the Good News. (Fishing, waterfall trekking, island hopping, snorkeling, fly fishing, sewing, cooking, and more.) It's not as easy as some other places but come use your skills to be a FISHER OF MEN. Don't know how to fish for "fish" or "men"....???? No worries, we will teach you. There are no known believers in this target group. You will learn fishing, go hiking, and see the majestic island sights to gain access to a normally inaccessible people. Through this tourism avenue of a once a week planned trip, you will be traveling to places Christians have never gone. As you navigate new culture and new relationships through everyday life, you will have the opportunity to share the Good News. Your first stop after you leave home will be a joint orientation with other Nehemiah Teams (NT). You will return to the U.S. for a joint debrief with other Nehemiah Teams. Participants must attend the entire program from NT Orientation through the end of debriefing.

LOCATION: Southeast Asia

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must have a passport or have applied for one by Feb. 4, 2022. Able to use your skills to become fishers of men: fishing, waterfall trekking, snorkeling, fly fishing, sewing, cooking.

AMOUNT YOU RAISE: \$2,750 (\$ 3,650 total cost of project)

Elevate Church Planting

MISSION FOCUS: Church Planting, Young Adults & Families DATE: June 1 - July 30, 2022, Orientation May 20 - 22, 2022

Come to the fastest growing area in our state to help plant the Gospel with new church plants. Our main interest is planting the Gospel into the lives of the people rather than just seeing a church started. You will help with two church plants located between Longmont (north Denver) and Fort Collins/Loveland area. These new churches focus on young professionals and young families. The church plants are relational in nature and do missional activity to not only start a church but to love their city! We utilize servant and relational evangelism, home Bible study fellowships and scouting. You need to be willing to build bridges with people of varying world-views and walks of life that are often far outside of the church culture. You will learn to identify spiritually open people by applying the "persons of peace" strategy in Luke 10:2b-11 and learn how to ask common-ground questions to gain understanding by hearing the person's story and then sharing God's story. Your focus will be three-fold: Know God more, know yourself more, and know people (your field) more. Mark 10:45 is the key theme: here to serve, not to be served, even though your life will be deeply enriched and very likely changed!

LOCATION: Loveland, CO

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must be a Sophomore or above (in second year of college after high school graduation). Spiritually and emotionally mature students who have lived away from home. You need to be outgoing, have mature social skills, able to think creatively and invest in people. Have a growing relationship with God, been discipled one-on-one or have an interest in learning how to disciple. Prefer students who have been exposed to

Colorado or out West. Like the outdoors and able to be highly active (okay with using a bike from time to time as transportation). Spanish is helpful, but not required. Spiritual gifts like exhortation, mercy, evangelism, service, and administration are helpful.

MISSION FOCUS: Urban Outreach

You will have the opportunity to serve in our food bank (The Giving Room), give out free coffee in partnership with our cafe Pilgrim Coffeehouse, and engage in spirit-driven, gospel conversations with the diverse people that make up our neighborhood. Throughout the summer, your bold faithfulness will transform lives in the name of Jesus; helping us in our vision of transforming North Seattle by finding an epic life in Jesus Christ.

LOCATION: Seattle, WA

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must be willing to be bold in sharing your faith, step out of your comfort zone, be flexible, be open to the leading of the Holy Spirit, and be mature enough to be respectful and gracious to those who may disagree with you.

Family Ministry Intern

MISSION FOCUS: Justice Ministry, Social Work, Art, Hospitality

DATE: May 23 - Aug. 1, 2022, Orientation May 20 - 22, 2022

Spend the summer assisting a family ministry that provides lodging, meals, and spiritual support for hurting families who come to visit their loved one, who is in prison here in the Texas Prison System. If you love to be around individuals and enjoy conversations with people, this is the perfect opportunity for you. You need to be outgoing, energetic, and capable of finding joy in everyday activities. The services we provide meet the needs of various aspects of the family's lives, which in turn leads to the development of lasting relationships. Come prepared to serve people from all over the state, USA and the world as you host them in a friendly, "home away from home" atmosphere with a warm meal, cozy bed, and open arms. There are also lots of opportunities to play games or read to the children from these families, share your faith, plan and conduct Bible studies, and assist our art teacher during therapeutic art sessions with the children each weekend.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must be a Sophomore or above (in second year of college after high school graduation). Cheerful, team player, empathetic, compassionate, slow to judge, self motivated, outgoing, energetic, friendly, flexible, have problem-solving abilities, have a

passion for the Lord and His people. Majors helpful: Social Work, Education, Media Communications, Criminal Justice, Sociology, Psychology or Art.

Handicrafts that bring HOPE

MISSION FOCUS: Women's Ministry, Unreached

Peoples, Church Planting

DATE: May 23 - July 4, 2022, Orientation

In 2017 we started a small handicraft project as an attempt to gain entrance into communities and into women's lives with the goal of sharing the Gospel and planting house churches. It very quickly grew into a huge project and eventually a non-profit of its own. What we

have seen over the last few years is that, despite the often horrifying realities they live in, a tiny piece of hope can change everything. As our women meet in small groups, build community, and meet weekly to hear Bible stories and pray for each other, they begin to carry each other's burdens. Through the stories, they begin to learn that they do have worth, purpose, and skills and a small flame of hope sparks. They start believing they might be good at something and that they might be worth more than they have been told. Then, they start believing there might be something to this Jesus. That is what this project is all about. Join us for a summer of investing in the lives of women, their families, and their communities as we share the Gospel, disciple, and start house churches among the lost!

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must have a passport or have applied for one by Feb. 4, 2022. Must be a Junior or above (in third year of college after high school graduation). Mature, grounded in faith, able to adjust quickly to new surroundings, and willing to work hard.

Infinity Sports & Recreation Camp

MISSION FOCUS: Sports Camps, Children DATE: May 28 - July 22, 2022, Orientation May 20 - 22, 2022

If you wish to share your faith through sports or to learn how to share your faith through sports, this is for you. You will be busy, you will travel, you will learn to work together

as a team, you will sweat, you will be tired, but you will be blessed and have a summer you will long remember. You will serve at multiple churches conducting Sports Camps

for students grade 1-6. You will be trained to share Christ through Storying, leading a Sport Time, sharing in Worship, teaching a recreational track so kids can use it as ministry, and spending downtime with campers. Be prepared to minister to numerous elementary-age students, have contact with many adults, and learn skills that will prove to be useful in the future.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Need to be teachable and able to teach. Need to desire to be part of a Biblically-based team and desire to contribute positively to the health of the

Making South Asian Disciples

MISSION FOCUS: Immigrants, Urban Ministry

DATE: May 23 - July 22, 2022, Orientation May 20 - 22, 2022

We work among Muslims, Hindus, Buddhists, and Sikhs; primarily people from the least-reached people groups of South Asia. Our church was planted 5 years ago in the beautifully diverse neighborhood of Jackson Heights, Queens NYC. We began gathering every Sunday at a Muslim restaurant to cultivate a disciple-making culture of "go to them" rather than "come to us". We trust in Jesus' promise "No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws them, and I will raise them up at the last day." (John 6:44). As a church, we run the South Asian Community Center in the heart of our neighborhood. At the Center, we offer Free ESL, citizenship, and computer classes throughout the year. Your main objective is to find "persons of peace" and seekers from a non-Christian background and disciple them into the way of Jesus. You will be trained and equipped to share the Gospel and engage lostness in our unique South Asian context. Some of your priorities and activities for the summer will be helping with English classes and after-school programs at the Community Center, following-up with new students and seekers at the Community Center, engaging in conversations at "Diversity Plaza" and community parks, visiting homes and businesses of "persons of peace," training mission teams, and serving at our local church. You will greatly multiply our efforts to reach the last frontiers of unreached people groups whom God is Sovereignly bringing here "so that they would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him." (Acts 17:27)

While we spend time with students and their families, we look for Spirit-led opportunities to share Truth through Bible stories. We also share our faith in everyday situations. You will be part of the Refugee Ministry Team for the summer, engaging with refugee kids in our summer kids' program, meeting their families, and experiencing the life of a local missionary to refugee families. The summer education enrichment program will run 3 days per week. The program will take place in an apartment. Outside of the program, you'll visit the families of these kids in their homes. As a chaplain intern, you will assist the chaplain with providing worship opportunities, religious education programs, and a variety of personal counseling needs while complying with all applicable rules, policies, and procedures related to security. You will also attend and participate in the youth/collegiate ministry of Covenant Fellowship Baptist Church, under the supervision of the Pastor and Student Pastor. Specific activities at the church include: preaching and sharing testimony in worship services, teaching youth and college Sunday School classes, participating in youth and college evangelistic outreach programs, participating in special outreach music concerts, seminars and workshops, and teaching Vacation Bible School.

Rural Health & Nutrition Training

MISSION FOCUS: Nutrition Trainings, Medical Missions

DATE: June 2 - Aug. 1, 2022, Orientation May 20 - 22, 2022

Good health and nutrition are a challenge in the rural areas of the Philippines. Poverty has been described as "Not a lack of money, but a lack of choices." By being a part of this rural healthcare team, you will work with Filipino healthcare workers, live in rural villages, learn from those who live on less than \$1 a day, and bring Christ's love and help to the "least of these." Daily ministry will include personal evangelism, children's healthcare, Bible classes, assisting local healthcare workers with basic medical procedures, teaching/demonstrating basic first aid, and teaching/demonstrating basic nutrition through establishing gardens. Your first stop after you leave home will be a joint orientation with other Nehemiah

Teams. You will return to the U.S. for a joint debrief with other Nehemiah Teams. Participants must attend the entire program from NT Orientation through the end of debriefing.

Students with severe food allergies or food preferences may want to consider other options as your needs may not be able to be accommodated. If you have ongoing needs or medication management or counseling related to depression, anxiety, PTSD, or sexual abuse, these resources are generally unavailable.

The next best thing to being an overseas missionary is to serve as a missionary in an apartment in Houston. Your apartment complex will contain more Hindus, Muslims, and Buddhists than Christians. You will hear other languages spoken more often than English. The smell of masala will permeate your apartment complex. Your living room will have a large Afghan carpet with cushions and no sofas or entertainment system. When neighbors enter your apartment, they will feel at home. Each week you and your roommate will meet with your missionary team to discuss strategies for ministering to your neighbors and indigenous ways of sharing the good news of Jesus. Your goal is to establish an ongoing Bible study with your apartment neighbors on your living room rug. Your team will reach out to local churches for the purpose of involving them in mission work. You will become proficient in leading church groups on tours in local mosques and temples. Churches will donate diapers, furniture, and food for the needy living among you. Monthly volunteer mission groups from around the U.S. will come work alongside you. When you complete this assignment, your parents and friends will not recognize you. You will be
