SERVE MINISTRIES

These ministries open the door for more effective sharing of the gospel.

Special Association Allocations

Fund mission and ministry initiatives developed by associations to assist their churches to accomplish the Great Commission and Great Commandment.

\$50,000

BOUNCE Hispanic/Bilingual Student Scholarships

The funds will provide partial scholarship assistance for Hispanic and/or bilingual students to participate in a BOUNCE Mission.

\$7,500

BOUNCE Coordinator Travel & Logistics

Coordinators travel to the communities for project (home) selection and other logistics. Funds will offset travel and logistics expenses.

\$8,000

BOUNCE Program Support

Funds will be used to assist with shower unit support for volunteers who support BOUNCE Missions.

\$5,000

Recharge

To equip African American churches with tools, techniques, and resources to evangelize local communities with funds for facilitators, registration for students.

\$10,000

Paul to Timothy Training Mentorship Monthly montoring for Hispanic paster

Monthly mentoring for Hispanic pastors to include curriculum and logistics.

\$12,500

Church Starting Replants

To assist dying churches in the effort to replant and grow again. Funds will be used for training, assessment, and consulting

\$20,000

Church Starting

Funding new church starts will provide for evangelism, discipleship, core group development, leadership development, programs, and outreach events.

\$725,000

Chaplain, Pastor, and Staff Training

Funds will grant \$175 per BGCT church member or endorsed chaplain trained in disaster spiritual care, suicide intervention, victim assistance, Hands on Ministry, and leadership training.

\$10,000

PAVE for Ethnic Minorities

To provide pastors of ethnic minorities with resources for revitalization through PAVE. The Texas Baptists Church Revitalization Strategy is designed to help customize revitalization for their context by equipping them with resources and placing them in cohorts.

\$12,000

Apartment Church Ministry

Sponsor churches and catalysts will benefit from funds with the work of networking and training leaders and members of the Apartment Church to reach their complexes and develop pastors.

\$20,000

Church Starting Vision Trips

Funds will provide materials to connect Texas Baptists churches with mission opportunities, working alongside Church Planting, MAP, and Strategic Development.

\$5,000

Urban Afterschool Program

Helping churches begin an afterschool program based on the needs of the community.

\$10,000

Small Church Impact Grants (Collaboration of Bivocational Ministry and Church Architecture)

Consultations and Project Funding Grants. The consultations provide experienced facilities planning. Project grants provide funds for executing the action plans developed.

\$240,000

Project Start

Project: Start is a refugee referral center. Funds help provide for space, supplies, evangelistic materials, partnerships with churches, equipment, and various refugee needs.

\$15,000

Hispanic Soccer Outreach - "La Mano de Dios"

Reaching the lost through the sport of soccer. This ministry provides the "La Mano de Dios" devotional book to each person receiving Christ.

\$5,000

Hispanic Summer Missionaries

45 students participate in a week of intensive training on disciples making disciples. Provision of funds include housing, travel, and meals.

\$20,000

Children's Ministry Initiative (African American Ministries)

This conference will help equip, train, and inform children's leaders on how to develop strong lifegiving children's ministries. Funds will be used for curriculum, scholarships, materials, and marketing.

\$4,000

Campus Missions Project (African American Ministries)

Trainings and seminars on Historically Black Campus Universities (HBCU) to train in the areas of leadership, discipleship, evangelism, dating violence, and other rising campus issues. Funds will be used for materials, curriculum, scholarships, and venues.

\$20,000

African American Health Initiative

Health support for African American churches and communities will receive help through funds for resources, venue, screenings, informational forums, and medical and mental health support.

\$4,000

African American Go Now Summer Missionaries

Funds will be disbursed for scholarships to supplement student's out-of-pocket expenses.

\$10,000

Camp Exalted

This camp is designed to equip and encourage African American students to share the gospel of Jesus. Funds will be used for equipment, curriculum, and scholarships.

\$25,000

Mission Arlington Christmas Break Trip (Baptist University of the Américas)

Funds will help offset the cost of lodging, meals, and transportation for a group of 15 students.

\$5,000

Set Apart Missions (Baptist University of the Américas)

Funds will be used provide for travel, materials, and scholarships, as students serve in Vacation Bible Schools, youth ministries, and ministries with immigrants.

\$11,000

Students on Mission, International (South Texas Children's Home Ministries)

Providing an opportunity for older students to experience missions in an active, handson way in the Dominican Republic. Funds will provide for travel and land costs in the country.

\$7,500

ADVANCE MISSIONS LEADERSHIP

These ministries equip both clergy and laity as they share the gospel and serve others.

Mega Focus Funding (Associations: Dallas, San Antonio, Tarrant, Union, and Austin)

Fund strategic missions or ministry initiatives developed by mega association leadership to assist their churches to accomplish the Great Commission and Great Commandment.

Borderland Association Funding (Associations: El Paso, Del Rio-Uvalde, Big Bend, Rio Grande Valley, Laredo)

Fund missions and ministry initiatives developed by borderland associations to assist their churches in accomplishing the Great Commission and Great Commandment.

\$45,000

GCT English Speaking Spanish Initiative

The growing segment within the growth of Hispanics is the third and fourth generation Hispanics who speak English and limited Spanish. Funds will train and equip churches to reach this people group.

\$7,000

[un]Apologetic Evangelism Conference

Three conferences will receive funds for scholarships for students and pastors, as well, as networking and promotion.

\$10,000

Church Starting Assessments

Funds will be used for materials, assessors, facilities, and assessment tools.

\$15,000

Church Planting Centers

Funds will support five Church Planting Centers across Texas. Each Church Planting Center will equip six to eight church planting candidates.

\$50,000

Leadership Development (River Ministry and Mexico Missions)

Funds will provide scholarships for seminary studies for pastors, leaders, and River Ministry missionaries, as well as a variety of training resources.

\$10,000

Missional Networks

To create missional mobilization networks across Texas. Each project that will be executed through this program will be led by a network of five churches.

\$7,500

Embrace

Providing scholarships to young women that will equip, help identify their calling, and mobilize them to an area of ministry while providing a mentor.

\$7,500

Urban Pastors Peer Groups

Funds will be used to provide training materials and retreats for urban pastor development meetings.

\$3,500

The Pastors Common

Identifying, equipping, resourcing, and connecting millennial, and Gen Z Texas Baptists pastors to Texas Baptists life. Funds provided will be used for the pastors to attend meetings and conferences.

\$25,000

Devoted

This ministry will engage Texas Baptists young adults by entering spaces where they normally do life. Funds provided will host worship gatherings.

\$7,500

House Church Ministry

To build up the movement of house churches by assisting sponsoring churches and a catalyst to train new house church leaders.

\$50,000

Key Church Strategy/Minister of Missions

To offer program support that leads to training experience/practice, mission trips, outreach efforts, and missional education.

\$65,000

Texas Baptists Missionaries (Evangelism/ Discipleship/ Leadership)

Missionaries will benefit from the funds for Bibles, discipleship materials, training to develop new leaders, and a leadership retreat.

\$7,500

Mission Shaped Leadership Training

Helping local churches engage in Missional Leadership through events for racial reconciliation among pastors and local congregations.

\$4,500

Ethnic Youth Worker Scholarships

Conclave NextGen is an event designed to train all preschool through college leaders, at the same time. Scholarships for ethnic leaders.

\$6,200

Intercultural Events

The different language groups of Texas need contextualized training and fellowship to grow their leaders and to learn together what it means to be Christian in this new cultural context. Funds will provide for events, speakers, facilities, and supplies.

\$21,000

Intercultural Youth Ministries

Leadership training, youth outreach, and mission trips are ongoing throughout the school year and summer. Camp Fusion is held in the summer. Funds would provide materials, supplies, housing, scholarships, and camp/facilities.

\$25,000

Hispanic Leadership Conference

Train and equip pastors and leaders to lead their churches to be kingdom-minded churches requires funds for program support and training resources.

\$7,500

EntrenaT Centers in Action

Participating churches in a community outreach ministry will receive funds to implement mission projects.

\$10,000

Compañerismo Presidents in Action

Training is provided to the 40 Compañerismo presidents on how to lead their churches to missional. Funds provide travel, training, and ministry resources.

\$15,000

National African American Preaching Conference

Funds will be utilized to assist pastors, preachers, and church staff members with training, scholarships, and lodging at the Preaching Conference.

\$5,000

African American Regional Rallies

Regional Rallies will allow this ministry to reach Texas with training and techniques in evangelism, discipleship, missions, revitalization, workshop, and church growth. Funds will provide curriculum, scholarships, and workshop materials.

\$20,000

Micah 6:8 Conference

This conference will equip Texas Baptists in addressing critical social and ethical issues. Funds will pay for expenses in planning and executing this conference.

\$10,000

Ethnic Minority Scholarships

Providing ethnic minority students, attending one of the nine Texas Baptists universities. \$65,000

Royal Ambassadors State Staffers

Specialized training and materials for young men to serve in RA camps around Texas.

\$10,000

Hispanic Royal Ambassador Camp

Funds will provide scholarships for students and discipleship materials.

\$2,500

Minnesota / Wisconsin Convention

Funds will provide lodging and meals for pastors and wives attending a retreat.

\$15,000

Christian Latina Leadership Institute Leadership Trainings

The funds will be used to provide scholarships for students, materials for trainings, as well as expenses for ongoing Institute training programs in the United States and Mexico.

\$10,000

WMU of Texas Ministries

Funds the operations and ministry for WMU of Texas.

\$1,200,000

LOVE THE LEAST OF THESE

These ministries seek to serve those who are often overlooked such as special needs adults, victims of human trafficking, single parents, men needing employment/life skills, and people living in poverty.

Overcomer Conference

Funds will provide for professional counselors to speak at the conference on women and mental health.

\$5,000

State Employed Chaplain Training

Endorsed chaplains (city, county, state employed, or volunteer) will be trained in disaster spiritual care, suicide intervention, victim assistance, Hands on Ministry, and leadership.

\$10,000

Revitalization Support for Lower-Income Churches

To provide churches with budgets of \$150,000 or less with revitalization resources such as evaluations, training, certifications, reports, and consultations.

\$12,000

Border Community Outreach

Providing churches and local associations with resources to minister to immigrant centers, medical clinics, and evangelistic events in the border areas.

\$100,000

Border Crisis Ministry (River Ministry and Mexico Missions)

River Ministry will send resources to Baptist associations and organizations that work with immigrants and people in crisis

living in the border areas. Providing hygiene products, medicines, evangelistic tracts, Bibles, and other necessities.

\$18,000

Special Friends Retreat

An annual event that provides a worship/ camp experience for families that are impacted by special needs ministries. Funds will be used to provide lodging, meals, supplies for lessons and crafts.

\$30,000

School to Prison Pipeline / Literacy and Math

Funds will provide educational materials in the areas of reading and math, as well as conferences and workshops.

\$5,000

Domestic Violence

Funds will provide materials, curriculum, and a workshop venue that will address the issue of domestic violence that exists in the African American community.

\$5,000

ISAAC (Christian Life Commission)

To continue the ongoing immigration training and support to Texas Baptists churches.

\$25,000

Community Justice

These ministries touch the lives of individuals, families, and communities impacted by justice-related issues in a holistic manner, providing a Bible for an inmate or inmate's family member, and a safe place for a family to stay while visiting a family member in prison.

\$30,000

Community Care

Funds will provide community services, health clinics, food for residential adolescent programs, and more.

\$50,000

Human Trafficking

Ministering to the spiritual, physical, and emotional needs of trafficking victims and to equip and support churches and ministries seeking to meet those needs.

\$10,000

Women's Build

Estimation to construct a new home in the El Polvorin Colonia in Peñitas, Texas is \$50,000. Funds for this ministry will be used for purchasing supplies and an on-site construction coordinator.

Scholarships will be issued up to 10 scholarships per semester for a student attending a Texas Baptists university.

\$10,000

Campus Outreach and Evangelism

Funds will be distributed to campuses in grants of \$250 to \$500 to help with costs of outreach events and activities on the campus.

\$5,000

BSM International Student Ministries

Funds will be distributed in grants for \$200 to \$500 to campuses that have an international ministry. They will be used to purchase bibles and discipleship materials. \$5,000

Go Now Missions

Funds will be used to assist with training, travel, and living expenses for students serving in Texas, United States, and abroad. Funds will cover costs of a special Go Now team, as well, as Christmas break missionaries, semester missionaries, summer missionaries, Impact missionaries, and campus missionaries.

\$20,000

Beach Reach Mission Trip (Baptist University of the Américas)

Funds will be used to provide partial scholarships for students to take part in Beach Reach in South Padre Island.

\$2,000

Missions in Monterrey Mexico (Baptist University of the Américas)

A group of 20-25 students will benefit from funds for materials used for witnessing and New Testaments, as well, as travel expenses.
