SHARING OF THE GOSPEL.

SPECIAL ASSOCIATION ALLOCATION
Funds mission and ministry initiatives developed
by associations to assist their churches to
accomplish the Great Commission and Great
Commandment.

\$40,000

**BOUNCE COLLEGIATE STAFF
PROGRAM SUPPORT**
Funds will assist four collegiate staff interns to
help implement BOUNCE Missions in the summer
of 2026.

\$7,500

**BOUNCE COORDINATOR TRAVEL
AND LOGISTICS**
Provides coordinator's travel to the communities
for project (home) selection and other logistics.
Funds will offset travel and logistic expenses.

\$8,000

**BOUNCE HISPANIC/BILINGUAL
STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS**
These funds provide partial scholarship
assistance for Hispanic and/or bilingual
students to participate in a BOUNCE Mission.

\$5,500

**[UN]APOLOGETIC EVANGELISM
CONFERENCE**
Conferences receive funds to scholarship
students and pastors, as well as networking
and promotion.

\$10,000

CHURCH STARTING REPLANTS
Funds assist in helping churches that are
declining or changing in their communities to
initiate growth through training, assessment,
and consulting.

\$20,000

NEW CHURCH STARTS
Funds new church starts by providing
evangelism opportunities, discipleship, core
group development, leadership development,
programs, and outreach events.

\$575,000

CHURCH STARTING ASSESSMENTS
Funds will be used for materials, assessors,
facilities, and assessment tools.

\$15,000

CHAPLAINCY TRAINING EVENTS
Funds grant \$175 per BGCT church member or
endorsed chaplain trained in disaster spiritual
care, suicide intervention, victim assistance,
Hands on Ministry, and leadership training.

\$10,000

HOUSE CHURCH
Assists the organic churches network to reach
the lost population of Texas with training and
grants for projects within the community.

\$29,800

PHILIPPI MINISTRY
Provides Bibles and materials for Christian
inmates to lead other inmates to Christ within
their own pod living group.

\$25,000

APARTMENT CHURCH
Funds will help organic churches network
with each other through training and projects
to reach the lost population of Texas.

\$25,000

SMALL CHURCH IMPACT GRANTS
Impact grants assist smaller membership
congregations to effectively reach their
communities for Christ. Regional trainings for
bivocational pastors and smaller communities
benefit from the funds provided.

\$200,000

PROJECT: START
A refugee referral center, funds help provide for
space, resources, and evangelistic materials
to meet the physical and spiritual needs of
refugees.

\$15,000

**HISPANIC SOCCER OUTREACH
"LA MANO DE DIOS"**
Reaching the lost through the sport of soccer,
this ministry provides the "La Mano de Dios"
devotional book to each person receiving Christ.

\$5,000

HISPANIC SUMMER MISSIONARIES
Twenty students embark on a week of intensive
training on disciples making disciples. Funds
provide for resources, housing, travel, and meals.

\$20,000

CAMPAMENTO

Provides funds for an event to include worship, fellowship, teaching and serving in a mission project to empower the future leaders of Hispanic youth.

\$10,000

AFRICAN AMERICAN MINISTRIES GO NOW SUMMER MISSIONARIES

Funds are disbursed for scholarships to supplement student's out-of-pocket expenses.

\$10,000

HISPANIC ROYAL AMBASSADOR CAMP

Funds will provide scholarships for students and discipleship materials for campers to attend RA Camp in Menard, Texas.

\$2,500

STUDENTS ON MISSION: DOMINICAN REPUBLIC (SOUTH TEXAS CHILDREN'S HOME MINISTRIES)

Provides an opportunity for older students to experience active, hands-on missions in the Dominican Republic, funding travel assistance and ground costs in the country.

\$3,500

ADVANCE MISSIONS LEADERSHIP

THESE MINISTRIES EQUIP BOTH CLERGY AND LAITY AS THEY SHARE THE GOSPEL AND SERVE OTHERS.

MEGA FOCUS FUNDING

(ASSOCIATIONS: AUSTIN, DALLAS, SAN ANTONIO, TARRANT, AND UNION)

Funds strategic missions or ministry initiatives developed by mega association leadership to assist their churches to accomplish the Great Commission and Great Commandment.

\$90,000

BORDERLAND ASSOCIATION FUNDING (ASSOCIATIONS: BIG BEND, DEL RIO-UVALDE, EL PASO, LAREDO, RIO GRANDE VALLEY)

Funds missions and ministry initiatives developed by borderland associations to assist their churches in accomplishing the Great Commission and Great Commandment.

\$40,000

WOMEN IN MINISTRY NETWORK

Funds will assist women in vocational ministry to receive training, coaching, mentoring, and a network of support.

\$10,000

GCT ENGLISH SPEAKING SPANISH INITIATIVE

Funds will provide resources to train Hispanic but English speaking churches and pastors.

\$5,000

CHURCH STARTING VISION TRIP

Funds provide materials to connect Texas Baptists churches and Church Planters with mission opportunities.

\$3,500

CHURCH PLANTING CENTER

Funds will assist with the purchase of materials needed to train planters/pastors for future ministry.

\$30,000

REVITALIZATION SUPPORT FOR ETHNIC MINORITIES

Funds will provide pastors of ethnic minorities with resources for revitalization strategy, designed to equip with resources and placing them in cohorts.

\$6,000

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT (RIVER MINISTRY AND MEXICO MISSIONS)

Funds provide scholarships for seminary studies for pastors, leaders, and River Ministry missionaries, as well as a variety of training resources.

\$10,000

KEY CHURCH STRATEGY/MINISTER OF MISSIONS

To provide assistance to help people lead and move towards a missional lifestyle. Program support that leads to training, mission trips, outreach efforts, and missional education.

\$50,000

TEXAS BAPTISTS MISSIONARIES

Provides funding for Bibles, discipleship materials, training to develop new leaders, and a leadership retreat for state missionaries.

\$5,000

CONCLAVE ETHNIC WORKER SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are provided for ethnic leaders to attend Conclave NextGen, an event designed to train ministry leaders of preschool through college-age students.

\$6,200

INTERCULTURAL EVENTS

The different language groups of Texas need contextualized training and fellowship to grow their leaders and learn together what it means to be a Christian in a new cultural context. Funds provide events, speakers, facilities, and supplies.

\$20,000

ENTRENA T CENTERS IN ACTION

Funds provided will teach, train and equip pastors, church leaders, and church planters. Students have the opportunity to lead a mission project in their community or partner with another church.

\$10,000

COMPAÑERISMO PRESIDENTS IN ACTION

Participating churches in a community outreach ministry will receive funds to implement mission projects.

\$15,000

HISPANIC LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE

Funds provide for program support and training resources to train and equip pastors and leaders to build kingdom-minded churches.

\$7,500

AFRICAN AMERICAN MINISTRIES CAMPUS MISSIONS PROJECTS

Funds provide materials, curriculum, and scholarships for trainings and seminars on Historically Black Campus Universities (HBCU) in the areas of leadership, discipleship, evangelism, dating violence, and other campus issues.

\$20,000

AFRICAN AMERICAN MINISTRIES REGIONAL RALLIES

Regional Rallies reach Texas with training and techniques in evangelism, discipleship, missions, revitalization, and church growth. Funds provide curriculum, scholarships, and workshop materials.

\$20,000

AFRICAN AMERICAN MINISTRIES HEALTH INITIATIVE

Funds will provide health and wellness information and resources to pastors, churches, and African American communities during the African American Ministries conferences and events.

\$4,000

ETHNIC MINORITY SCHOLARSHIP

Provides scholarships for ethnic minority students attending a Texas Baptist university.

\$66,000

THE PASTOR'S COMMON

Funds will provides for four statewide preaching and leadership labs for millennial pastors.

\$20,000

CHRISTIAN LATINA LEADERSHIP TRAININGS

Provides scholarships for students, materials for training, and expenses for ongoing institute training programs in the United States, Colombia, and Mexico.

\$10,000

MINNESOTA/WISCONSIN CONVENTION
Funds provide lodging and meals for the annual pastors and wives retreat.

\$10,000

CAMPOUT & MISSIONS MANIA (ROYAL AMBASSADORS)

Funds provide an annual experience where RA's learn about mission work, introduction to the gospel, and have the opportunity to mature in their faith.

\$5,000

ROYAL AMBASSADORS STATE STAFFERS

Provides specialized training and materials for young men to serve in RA camps across Texas.

\$5,000

LOVE THE LEAST OF THESE

THESE MINISTRIES SEEK TO SERVE THOSE WHO ARE OFTEN OVERLOOKED SUCH AS SPECIAL NEEDS ADULTS, VICTIMS OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING, SINGLE PARENTS, MEN NEEDING EMPLOYMENT/LIFE SKILLS, AND PEOPLE LIVING IN POVERTY.

REVITALIZATION SUPPORT FOR LOWER-INCOME CHURCHES

To provide assistance for churches with budgets of \$150,000 or less with revitalization resources such as evaluations, trainings, certifications, reports, and consultations.

\$6,000

BORDER CRISIS MINISTRY (RIVER MINISTRY AND MEXICO MISSIONS)

Provides resources to the border with assistance of medicines and hygiene kits in McAllen, Reynosa, Matamoros, El Paso/Juarez.

\$18,000

BORDER COMMUNITY OUTREACH (RIVER MINISTRY AND MEXICO MISSIONS)

Funds resources to Baptist associations and churches with resources to minister to immigrants' centers, medical clinics, and evangelistic events in the border areas.

\$70,000

SPECIAL FRIENDS RETREAT

Funds will provide lodging, meals, and supplies for lessons and crafts for an annual worship/camp experience for families of those with special needs and those who are special needs.

\$30,000

ISAAC (CHRISTIAN LIFE COMMISSION)

Provides funding for ongoing immigration training and support to Texas Baptists churches.

\$25,000

COMMUNITY CARE (CHRISTIAN LIFE COMMISSION)

Funds provide grants to Texas-based organizations who focus on community transformation through social services, healthcare, residential programs, and more.

\$45,000

COMMUNITY JUSTICE (CHRISTIAN LIFE COMMISSION)

This ministry touches the lives of individuals, families, and communities impacted by justice-related issues in a holistic manner, providing a Bible for an inmate or inmate's family member, and a safe place for a family to stay while visiting a family member in prison.

\$20,000

(VICTIMS OF) HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Provides funds for ministering to the spiritual, physical, and emotional needs of trafficking victims, and equips and supports churches and ministries seeking to meet those needs.

\$10,000

ACADEMIC SUCCESS FOR 1ST GEN AND ACCOMMODATIONS (EAST TEXAS BAPTIST UNIVERSITY)

Funds will provide technology and materials to support the assistance of students with accommodation needs and 1st generation students with training.

\$20,000

HEARTS, HANDS, AND FEET OF JESUS (HARDIN-SIMMONS UNIVERSITY, DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICAL THERAPY)

Students in the Doctor of Physical Therapy Program serve as short-term missionaries (STMs) for a child or adult with disabilities providing the families caring for them an opportunity for respite.

\$6,000

HELP FOR HOMES (VALLEY BATIST MISSIONS EDUCATION CENTER)

Funds will provide disaster relief to local poverty driven communities and poor-funded churches.

\$10,000

WOMEN'S BUILD

Funds will be used to purchase building materials for WMU of Texas volunteers to construct a new home for a family in the Texas Rio Grande Valley.

\$40,000

TELL MINISTRIES

THESE MINISTRIES ENABLE TEXAS BAPTISTS TO BE A WITNESS.

RECHARGE

Equips African American churches with tools, techniques, and resources to evangelize local communities with funds for facilitators and registration for students.

\$10,000

EVANGELISM TRAINING, WORKSHOPS, AND EVENTS

Funds provide Texas Baptists pastors and ministries with evangelism resources, initiatives, and training events.

\$10,000

CONGRESO

The Congreso Hispanic Conference is the largest annual gathering of Hispanic Baptist young people in North America. Funds provide scholarships and a Pastors Track in English and Spanish to equip in reaching the next generation.

\$20,000

ARENA OUTREACH EVENTS AND MISSIONS, AND TRAINING

Funds to partner with Cowboy Church Starts and small Cowboy Churches to provide missional outreach and evangelism events for community connection.

\$10,000

SPANISH TRANSLATION OF BIBLE STUDIES (GC2 PRESS)

Funds help translate and distribute free downloadable studies in Spanish through gc2press.org.

\$25,000

VISION TRIPS TO URBAN AREA

Funds events and trips to highlight the need of urban church plants and community ministries in urban cities.

\$3,500

HOUSE CHURCH

Funding assists organic churches network to reach the lost population of Texas with training and grants for projects within the community.

\$29,800

STRATEGIC OUTREACH

Reaching new people groups is most effective when they first arrive in the United States. Funds help congregations be prepared and empowered to share the gospel as they focus on outreach to new people groups.

\$12,000

INTERCULTURAL YOUTH MINISTRIES

Leadership training, youth outreach, and mission trips for intercultural youth are ongoing throughout the school year. Each summer, these funds provide materials, supplies, housing, scholarships, and camp/facilities for Camp Fusion.

\$25,000

WAVE AFRICAN AMERICAN MINISTRIES YOUTH AND NEXTGEN CAMP

Provides a camp designed to equip and encourage African American students to share the gospel of Jesus. Funds are used for equipment, curriculum, and scholarships.

\$25,000

FROM THE HARVEST FOR THE HARVEST (GO NOW MISSIONS)

Funds help Go Now Missionaries share the gospel across Texas, the United States, and multiple countries by providing assistance with training, travel, and living expenses.

\$20,000

CAMPUS OUTREACH AND EVANGELISM

Funds will be distributed to campuses in grants to help with costs of campus outreach events and activities.

\$7,5000

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT MINISTRY (BAPTIST STUDENT MINISTRY)

Funds will be distributed through grants to campuses who have an international ministry and will be used to purchase Bibles and other discipleship materials to assist with events.

\$5,000

MONTERREY MISSION TRIP (BAPTIST UNIVERSITY OF THE AMÉRICAS)

A group of 12-15 students benefit from funds used to purchase witnessing materials to serve those that are less fortunate.

\$7,000

SET APART MISSIONS (BAPTIST UNIVERSITY OF THE AMÉRICAS)

Funds will be used as students serve in different churches throughout Texas. The development of the student's leadership skills while speaking and interacting with a variety of people and ministries is a valuable opportunity.
