

# ALLOCATIONS

## PROPOSED FUNDING REQUESTS FOR 2027

### SERVE MINISTRIES

*These ministries open the door for more effective sharing of the Gospel.*

#### **Mega Focus Funding**

*(Associations: Austin, Dallas, San Antonio, Tarrant, and Union)*

To assist churches in these associations in reaching and discipling their large, diverse metropolitan communities.

**\$90,000**

#### **Special Association Allocations**

Special projects can be associational or church specific to be more effective in reaching and discipling the unreached populations in their communities.

**\$40,000**

#### **BOUNCE Collegiate Staff Program Support**

Funds will assist collegiate staff interns to help implement BOUNCE Missions in 2027.

**\$7,500**

#### **BOUNCE Coordinator (Travel & Logistics)**

Funds will offset travel and logistic expenses for the coordinator's travel to the communities for project (home) selection.

**\$8,000**

#### **BOUNCE Hispanic/Bilingual Student Scholarship Assistance**

Partial scholarships are funded for Hispanic and/or bilingual students to participate in a BOUNCE Mission.

**\$5,500**

#### **Evangelism Strategic Planning & Implementation**

Funds are designed to support the local church to be missional and evangelistic in their community.

**\$10,000**

#### **New Church Starts**

Funding will help support church planters, training for planters, outreach needs of specific churches, and a yearly retreat.

**\$534,750**

#### **Church Starting Assessments**

Funds will be used for materials, assessors, facilities, and assessment tools.

**\$15,000**

#### **Texas Chaplaincy Training Event**

Training, equipping, and providing mandatory continuing education for chaplains that relate to the military, hospitals, prisons, and other categories.

**\$20,000**

#### **MAP (Missionary Adoption Program) Mobilizer**

Cultivating relationships and providing support to current adopting partners. Funds will provide the mobilizer to continue presenting the vision of MAP.

**\$10,000**

#### **Hispanic Soccer Outreach "La Mano de Dios"**

Reaching the lost through the sport of soccer, this ministry provides the "La Mano de Dios" devotional book to each person receiving Christ.

**\$5,000**

#### **Hispanic Summer Missionaries**

Twenty students embark on a week of intensive training, preparing them for ministry of outreach or discipleship in their school, community, or local church.

**\$20,000**

#### **Campamento**

Provides funds for an event to include worship, fellowship, teaching, and serving in a mission project to empower the future leaders of Hispanic youth.

**\$10,000**

#### **Intercultural Events**

The different language groups of Texas need contextualized training and fellowship to grow their leaders and learn together what it means to be a Christian in a new cultural context. Funds provide events, speakers, facilities, and supplies.

**\$20,000**

#### **WAVE (African American Ministries Youth and Nextgen Camp)**

Provides a camp designed to equip and encourage African American students to share the Gospel of Jesus. Funds are used for equipment, curriculum, and scholarships.

**\$25,000**

#### **Key Church Strategy / Missional Church Ministries**

Grants for churches with average attendance below 250 people. Funds provide for mission projects.

**\$50,000**

#### **House Church**

Funding assists organic churches network to reach the lost population of Texas with projects within the community.

**\$30,000**

### **Multihousing Churches and Ministries for Apartment Churches**

Each apartment church can reach more unreached people than legacy ministries. Funds will provide for training leadership and outreach events.

**\$25,000**

### **Philippi Ministry**

Provides Bibles and materials for Christian inmates to lead other inmates to Christ within their own pod living group.

**\$25,000**

### **Bivocational / Smaller Membership Missional Church Mobilization and Church Architecture**

Impact grants assist smaller membership congregations to effectively reach their communities for Christ. Cohort and training programs for bi-vocational pastors.

**\$175,000**

### **African American Ministries Campus Missions Projects**

Funds provide materials, curriculum, and scholarships for training and seminars on Historically Black Campus Universities (HBCU) in the areas of leadership, discipleship, evangelism, dating violence, and other campus issues.

**\$20,000**

### **Help for Homes (Valley Baptist Missions Education Center)**

Provides a safe home environment for the community and/or church through construction and remodel because of natural disasters in the area.

**\$10,000**

### **Hispanic Royal Ambassador Camp**

Funds will provide scholarships for students and discipleship materials for campers to attend RA Camp in Menard, Texas.

**\$2,500**

### **Mission Monterrey (Baptist University of the Americas)**

Serving local churches in Mexico will make a lasting impact on participating students. Funds provide supplies for workshops, lodging, food, and travel.

**\$10,000**

### **Beach Reach (Baptist University of the Americas)**

Funds provide travel, supplies, and transportation for students who are sharing the Gospel to college students during Spring Break at South Padre Island.

**\$7,000**

### **Intercultural Events: Youth Ministry**

Leadership training, youth outreach, and mission trips throughout the year. The main summer event is Camp Fusion.

**\$25,000**

## **ADVANCE MISSIONS LEADERSHIP**

*These ministries equip both clergy and laity as they share the Gospel and serve others.*

### **Borderland Association Funding**

*(Associations: Big Bend, Del Rio-Uvalde, El Paso, Laredo, Rio Grande Valley)*

Funds missions and ministry initiatives developed by Borderland Associations to assist their churches in accomplishing the Great Commission and Great Commandment.

**\$40,000**

### **Women in Ministry Network**

Funds will assist women in vocational ministry to receive training, coaching, mentoring, and a network of support.

**\$10,000**

### **Recharge Evangelism Conference**

Designed to educate, empower, and equip African American Christian leaders to evangelize their community. Funds will provide each participant with materials, curriculum, and scholarships.

**\$10,000**

### **GCT English Speaking Spanish Initiative**

Funds will provide resources to train Hispanic and English speaking churches and pastors.

**\$12,000**

### **Church Replanting**

Funds will help 16 replants currently in the system to reach out to their new or changing communities.

**\$20,000**

### **Church Multiplication Pathway**

Equipping new church planters and spouses through targeted events, cohort coaching, mentoring, and field-ready materials.

**\$40,000**

### **Entrena-T Centers in Action**

Funds support the training and equipping for pastors, church leaders, and church planters to lead or participate in a mission project in their own community or in partnership with another church.

**\$10,000**

### **Compañerismo Presidents in Action**

Provides 40 Compañerismos Presidents help for churches to embrace a missional focus through training and ministry resources.

**\$15,000**

### **Hispanic Leadership Conference**

Funds provide program support and training resources for pastors, church planters, and leaders to build kingdom-minded churches.

**\$7,500**

### **African American Regional Rallies**

Regional Rallies will help equip African American churches in areas of leadership, evangelism, discipleship, and stewardship. Funds will provide scholarships, and curriculum for workshops.

**\$20,000**

### **African American Leadership Conference**

Funds will help assist churches with community empowerment, involvement, spiritual renewal, curriculum, and scholarships for students.

**\$7,500**

### **Conclave Ethnic Worker Scholarship**

Scholarships are designated for ethnic minority leaders who serve preschool, children, youth, college students, or senior pastors.

**\$8,000**

### **Texas Baptists Evangelism / Discipleship / Leadership**

Funds will be used for special requests from the Texas Baptists missionaries for items like Bibles and discipleship materials.

**\$5,000**

### **Leadership Development**

Scholarships for seminary studies and additional training opportunities are provided for pastors, leaders, and River Ministry missionaries.

**\$10,000**

### **Ethnic / Minority Scholarships**

Investing in emerging ethnic / minority Baptist leaders. These scholarships are available for qualifying students attending a Texas Baptist affiliated institution.

**\$66,000**

### **African American Ministries: Go Now Missions**

Funds scholarships for college students who engage in summer missions work.

**\$10,000**

### **African American Ministries: PAVE**

Provides an opportunity for pastors with churches in decline to receive help with a revitalization strategy.

**\$20,000**

### **Pastors Theological Training (Valley Baptist Missions Education Center)**

Funds will provide training and development of association pastors.

**\$10,000**

### **Missions Mania (Royal Ambassadors)**

Funds will be used to teach RAs about mission work, discipling young people to live mission-focused lives.

**\$5,000**

### **State Staffers (Royal Ambassadors)**

Funding provides training, materials, transportation, and meals enabling State Staffers to serve in RA mission camps around the state.

**\$5,000**

### **Christian Latina Leadership Institute Trainings**

Provides scholarships for students, materials for training, and expenses for ongoing institute training programs in the United States, Colombia, and Mexico.

**\$12,000**

### **Minnesota / Wisconsin Convention**

Funds provide lodging and meals for the annual pastors and wives retreat.

**\$15,000**

### **Intercultural Events**

The different cultural groups of Texas need contextualized training and fellowship to grow their leaders and learn together what it means to be a Christian in a new cultural context. Funds provide events, speakers, facilities, and supplies.

**\$25,000**

## LOVE THE LEAST OF THESE

*These ministries seek to serve those who are often overlooked such as special needs adults, victims of human trafficking, single parents, men needing employment/life skills, and people living in poverty.*

### **Project: Start**

A refugee referral center, funds help provide for space, resources, and evangelistic materials to meet the physical and spiritual needs of refugees.

**\$15,000**

### **Border Community Outreach Ministry (River Ministry and Mexico Missions)**

Funds resources to Baptist associations and churches with resources to minister to immigrants' centers, medical clinics, and evangelistic events in the border areas.

**\$70,000**

### **Border Crisis Ministry (River Ministry and Mexico Missions)**

Providing hygiene kits, hot food, medicines, and Gospel materials in McAllen, Reynosa, Matamoros, and El Paso/Juarez.

**\$10,000**

### **Special Friends Retreats**

Funds will provide lodging, meals, and supplies for lessons and crafts for an annual worship/camp experience for families of those with special needs and those who are special needs.

**\$30,000**

### **Health Initiative (African American Ministries)**

Health and wellness resources, informational forums, health fairs, and mental health support will be provided by funds from the MHDO.

**\$4,000**

### **Community Care (Christian Life Commission)**

Funds will be used to award Community Care grants to Texas Baptists affiliated ministries through comprehensive social services, healthcare, residential programs, and community programs.

**\$45,000**

### **Community Justice (Christian Life Commission)**

This ministry touches the lives of individuals, families, and communities impacted by justice-related issues. This includes but is not limited to public servants (wardens), incarcerated, and more.

**\$20,000**

### **(Survivors of) Human Trafficking**

Funds will be distributed through Anti-Human Trafficking grants to ministries focused on safe houses, restoration, and holistic services to survivors of human trafficking.

**\$15,000**

### **ISAAC (Immigration Service and Aid Center)**

Provides funding for the ongoing immigration training and support to Texas Baptists churches.

**\$25,000**

### **International Student Ministry (Baptist Student Ministry)**

Funds will be distributed to campuses across Texas for use in ministry projects to reach international students.

**\$7,500**

### **Women's Build**

Provides onsite assistance and costs for framing, electrical, plumbing, and roofing to construct a new home for a family in the Texas Rio Grande Valley.

**\$50,000**

### **Christian Job Corps**

Funds provide on-going support to the Christian Women's and Men's Job Corps in Texas.

**\$25,000**

### **Heart, Hands, and Feet of Jesus (Hardin-Simmons University, Department of Physical Therapy)**

Students in the Doctor of Physical Therapy Program serve as Short-Term Missionaries (STMs) for a child or adult with disabilities.

**\$12,000**

## **TELL MINISTRIES**

*These ministries enable Texas Baptists to be a witness.*

### **Congreso**

The Congreso Hispanic Conference is the largest annual gathering of Hispanic Baptist young people in North America. Funds provide scholarships and a Pastors track in English and Spanish to equip in reaching the next generation.

**\$20,000**

### **Paul to Timothy Training Mentorship**

Associational prayer emphasis for evangelism, coaching for key churches, and conferences with Hispanic pastors and their wives.

**\$5,000**

### **Spanish Bible Study Translation (GC2 Press)**

Funds provide the translation of four Connect 360 Bible Studies (study and teaching guides) into Spanish.

**\$25,000**

### **Strategic Outreach**

Reaching new people groups is most effective when they first arrive in the United States. Funds help congregations be prepared and empowered to share the Gospel as they focus on outreach to new people groups.

**\$12,000**

### **Western Heritage Arena Outreach Events & Missions**

Funds to partner with Cowboy Church Starts and small Cowboy Churches to provide missional outreach and evangelism events for community connection.

**\$10,000**

### **From the Harvest to the Harvest Fields (Go Now Missions)**

Funds help Go Now Missionaries share the Gospel across Texas, the United States, and multiple countries by providing assistance with training, travel, and living expenses.

**\$20,000**

### **Campus Outreach and Evangelism**

Funds will be distributed to 15 campuses in grants of \$750 to help with costs of campus outreach events and activities.

**\$11,250**
