Womans Missionary Union's principal focus encourages mentoring and discipleship. Mary Hill Davis' life depicts those qualities. During her presidency of WMU of Texas, Mary created and developed organizations to teach women about mission work, which led to the origin of Royal Ambassadors in 1908 and Girls Auxiliary in 1913. These organizations continue to disciple young boys and girls through missions stories and Bible stories.

Mary realized the mission field encompassed many challenges and opportunities. She saw the opportunity to alleviate some of those challenges by encouraging churches to pray and give to mission work. By advocating these needs, Mary provided financial stability for missionaries in the field by supporting the work of missions worldwide.

Mary saw the need to promote and support missions internationally and in her own state of Texas. Due to her commitment, the state missions offering became her namesake in 1935. Today, her legacy continues as the Mary Hill Davis Offering® for Texas Missions, which supports approximately 80 programs and ministries across the state.

## Special Friends Retreats

Every year, people with disabilities from around the state come together for either a day or a weekend of camp. Campers participate in Bible study, missions projects, and worship. 
**Family Activity:** Have a family talent show. Encourage each member of the family to share their talent. Pray for the Special Friends Retreats and the campers who will participate this year.


Pray for the young women as they prepare to live out their calling. Pray for the mentors who will walk alongside these women.

Pray for the students who will receive the scholarships this year. Pray for churches as they encourage and equip college students.





Pray for the boys and their leaders who will attend *Missions Mania* this year. Pray that the Holy Spirit would prepare their hearts for what they will see and hear.





Pray for the women who will build a home for a new family this fall. Pray for the family that will receive the home. Pray that they will come to know Jesus as the women build their new home.









### 1 | Lubbock, Texas & Cedar Hill, Texas

**Special Friends Retreat:** Pray for more churches to see the need for Special Needs Ministry, and pray for the health of the campers throughout the year.

### 2 | Midland, Texas

**Church Starting:** Pray for more sponsors and partner churches to walk alongside new church plants as they receive training in leadership, prayer, and ministry.

### 3 | Dallas, Texas

**Embrace:** Pray for the Embrace Mentors as they empower young women to fulfill their calling.

### 4 | Fort Worth, Texas

**Ethnic/Minority Scholarship Program:** Pray for the students receiving the scholarship to be encouraged and equipped to serve in ministry after graduation.

### 5 | Aquilla, Texas

**Missions Mania Camp:** Pray that the Holy Spirit will begin preparing the hearts of the young boys and men who will be in attendance at Missions Mania for Royal Ambassadors.

### 6 | Lufkin, Texas

**Christian Men's Job Corps:** Pray for the participants of our Christian Job Corps sites to hear and respond to the Gospel message, follow in believers' baptism, and that God will transform their lives as they surrender their whole selves to Him.

### 7 | Houston, Texas

**Apartment Churches:** Pray Apartment Churches will have more gospel conversations with people living in complexes and that management companies will continue to be open to letting ministries use their common areas.

### 8 | Peñitas, Texas

**Women's Build Project:** Pray for the Women's Build volunteers as they use the opportunity to build relationships to make a spiritual impact on the family and community through the build.
