Our State

Texas has 29 million people spread over 261,231 square miles with a median income of \$61,874 and per capita income of \$31,177. Fifty percent of Texas residents consider themselves Christian. 16.3% live in poverty. The state currently hosts 42 CWJC/CMJC sites.

Pray that CWJC/CMJC sites will reach those who are not believers in Christ. Pray that the yoke of poverty be broken in our state.

Our Site Leaders
